

You could lower your internet bill by \$30 a month!

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) offers eligible **Maine families** up to \$30 a month off their internet bill.

Who qualifies for the Affordable Connectivity Program?

A HOUSEHOLD IS ELIGIBLE IF EITHER their total income is **below 200%** of the Federal Poverty Level, **or one family member meets any of the criteria below:**

- **Participates in assistance programs**, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline;
- **Participates in one of several Tribal-specific programs;**
- **Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program**, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision;
- **Received a Federal Pell Grant** during the current award year;
- **Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating broadband provider's existing low-income program.**
